At Full Council on 22 February 2022, during the discussion of item 17 (Dog PSPO) it was noted by the Executive member for Recycling, Household Waste and Environmental Health (Dewhurst) that an extendible lead that is LOCKED WILL BE considered a FIXED lead. This is a very important point, but it is NOT included in the draft Minutes. Will you please add this to the minutes. Also, for complete clarity, will you please add it to the text of the PSPO.

Response from the Executive Member for Environmental Health, Recycling and Household Waste

Thank you for your question and I am glad that my response in the meeting of Full Council was helpful. Officers have added a definition to our webpage which states that a fixed lead is a fixed length or is an extendable lead in a fixed position set at no more than 1 metre in length, which attaches to your dog's collar or harness.
