Question from Stuart Reynolds

“With the discovery of *Vibrio Alginolyticus* in the river Teign at Shaldon last year, what plans does the Council have to respond to the potential threat to public health from the spread of *Vibrio* species bacteria as the temperature of the estuary rises. Specifically, will the Council install a remote water temperature monitor to provide warning of temperatures in excess of 18°C, as part of its response to the climate change emergency it declared in April 2019”
