

Employment Hubs

The Employment Hubs provide in-person support and information about different career options, jobs, and learning opportunities to adults and young people in Devon.

The advisers provide a triage service, engaging and directing the individual to the most appropriate route and where appropriate act as caseload officers, continuing to support the individual onto and through the next steps of their journey towards further training, education, or employment.

The hubs are working with other organisations and employers to give individuals the confidence and clarity they need, supporting them to move forward to what they want to do next.

The hubs are currently located in Exeter, Mid-Devon, North Devon, East Devon and they reported 708 referrals, 52 individuals into employment/self-employment, 18 into education, 24 into training and 62 referrals into Supported Employment.

Delivery options for 2025 – 2026:

Option 1: Employment hubs delivery according to indicative budget from interested districts (East Devon, Mid Devon, Exeter, Teignbridge and North Devon)

Option 2: Deliver across Districts in Devon according to demographics. This is an option to split our available resources across Devon considering the size of each area
